



## **Marlin Mine – Guatemala**

Goldcorp's Marlin Mine is in the western highlands of Guatemala, 48 kilometers southwest of the city of Huehuetenango, approximately 300 kilometers northwest Guatemala City. The project lies within a highly prospective land package of approximately 100,000 hectares that encompasses the main Marlin deposit and other important mineralized zones.

The Marlin Mine is a conventional milling operation with a combination of open pit and underground mining. Commercial production commenced in the fourth quarter of 2005 and in its first full year of production Marlin achieved 161,000 ounces of gold and 1.6 million ounces of silver.
