



## Goldcorp – Éléonore Project

The Éléonore project is host to the Roberto Deposit, a major new gold discovery situated within a relatively unexplored greenstone/meta-sedimentary belt in the James Bay district of Northern Québec, Canada. At year end 2008, the Éléonore resource was calculated at more than 5 million ounces indicated and inferred. Progress was made on establishing site infrastructure at Éléonore and work is being done to advance internal feasibility models based on a higher-grade resource model.

The Éléonore project is expected to be developed into a fly-in, fly-out (FIFO) camp with an underground mine operation and a conventional gold milling circuit.
